1. Vote, vote, vote!

- **<u>Start here</u>** to make sure you're registered to vote
- Bookmark this site because they provide amazing voting guides and can help you create your voting plan
- Voting is fun! Find a friend to hold you accountable and make it even more fun!



2. Know your reps

- Find who represents you <u>here</u>
- Make a contact in your phone for each of your reps
- Sign up for their newsletters
- Reach out to them in any way you're willing (sample script below):

3. Follow education advocacy groups

- Sign up for their alerts and newsletters to stay up to date
- Follow them on social media

5. Can't go to the Capitol but want to be heard?

Everyone can't make the trip to Austin but your voice is still important!

- Email your representative and senator
- Call your representative and senator
- Send them a letter or post card
- Tweet (or X) at them



6. Post on social media daily

- Lawmakers need to know we're watching and that we don't want vouchers
- Tag us and other groups in your posts so we can amplify each other

Need help getting started? Sample language for calls and letters:

I am against any education voucher program of any size.

They will harm public education by diverting funds from our public schools that are already significantly underfunded.

We must commit to fully funding public schools. We must commit to meeting our Texas Constitutional obligation to provide a free public education to EVERY child.

We must commit to paying our teachers what they deserve and addressing our state's significant teacher shortage.

The time to protect our children and public education is now. This matters to me because....
